- (5/5/23) Subcommittees' taskforce on common data elements reviewed catalog of survey questions from all Research Centers which will help identify common data elements.

Participant Engagement:

- (4/10/23) Subcommittees' taskforce discussed project and paper to catalog engagement and engagement optimization activities being applied across Research Centers.
 Determined next steps to include developing IRB protocol for the cataloging effort.
- (4/13/23) UNM/TGen presented about activities related to their Participant Engagement Unit (PEU) and Engagement Optimization Unit (EOU).

Return of Results:

- (4/26/23) UNM/TGen presented a survey to collect baseline data from cancer center providers on their return of results process.
- (5/12/23) Subcommittee has developed a cross-Network survey on cascade testing and

interested Research Centers can apply for collaborative set-aside funds to implement the survey.


Cancer Grand Challenges - Global research funding opportunities with nine new challenges
