Approval for Three Collaborative Proposals

Congratulations to researchers from across the Network who received approval from the Steering Committee for their collaborative proposals. Here are the main goals of each proposal:

- **Cascade Testing in the PE-CGS Network**: To study how families communicate germline test results, what factors influence cascade testing, and what barriers and facilitators exist for cascade testing.
- cfDNA methylation analysis in CRC for MRD detection in Hispanic/Latinos and African Americans: To develop liquid biopsies based on cfDNA methylation for detecting MRD in CRC patients from underrepresented groups.
- Understanding and Engaging Decliners to Genetic Sequencing Research (PE-CGS) Network: To investigate why underrepresented individuals decline to participate in cancer genomic sequencing studies and to develop ethical responses based on their reasons.

Subcommittee Updates

Health Equity:

- (8/1/23) The subcommittee met and discussed the panel discussion for the upcoming Annual Meeting. They brainstormed topics and questions to address during the panel as well as potential people to sit on the panel. Topics and questions for the panel will be shared with the Annual Meeting planning group.
- (No Meeting) The health equity subcommittee's Common Data Elements task force did not meet this month.

Participant Engagement:

- (8/10/23) The subcommittee met and Count Me In presented about activities related to their Participant Engagement Unit (PEU) and Engagement Optimization Unit (EOU).
- (No Meeting) The subcommittee's Engagement Catalog task force did not meet this month because they have started conducting structured interviews for their task force activities.

Return of Results:

- (8/4/23) The subcommittee's working group on cascade testing met and continued discussions about cross-center collaborations on cascade testing, including project goals, timelines and funding.
- (8/9/23) The subcommittee resumed meetings this week and plans to meet monthly in advance of the Annual Meeting. They discussed next steps for the collaborative paper about germline variants of uncertain significance (VUS), including possible cases to highlight. A discussion on the use of somatic results in determining the pathogenicity of VUS results will take place next meeting.
